

Frequently Asked Questions

What is Bridge-Boost 2?

Bridge-Boost 2 is an in-person math acceleration program for students who meet Prep-English requirements but need a strong math foundation to skip the Prep-Year.

Who is eligible for Bridge-Boost 2?

Students must meet Prep-English requirements, have a valid IELTS score of 6.0 or TOEFL score of 70 or higher, and reside near KFUPM. In addition, they should have earned a high score on the KFUPM Math Early Admission Test.

What subject is covered in Bridge-Boost 2?

Students study Math012, which includes fundamentals of Algebra and Trigonometry.

How long is Bridge-Boost 2?

The program lasts 8 weeks, starts on March 29, and requires 8 hours of study per week, for a total of 64 instructional hours.

Is there a fee for Bridge-Boost 2?

Yes. There is a fee of 2,000 Saudi Riyals, which is refundable upon successful completion of the program and completing one term at KFUPM.

Are seats limited?

Yes. Seats for Bridge-Boost 2 are very limited.

Are there exams?

Yes. There will be Quizzes, Midterm exam and Final comprehensive exam

What if I fail the program?

If you do not pass the program, you can take the Math placement tests in August 2026. However, program fees will not be refunded in this case.

How about if I decide to take the placement test in August 2026 instead of joining the program?

Passing the Boost 2 program offers a faster track to start as a freshman student. It allows you to skip both the math and the PYP courses. However, if you take the placement test and are placed in Math 012, you'll be required to complete two PYP modular courses and a full semester PYP course.

Is the program online or in-person?

All classes for the program will be held in-person at KFUPM. There is no online option available.
